"Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him."

1 John 5:14-15

y mom used to remind me of a wonderful truth, "never underestimate the power of prayer." I believe this is true, especially when you are praying according to God's will. How do we know what God's will is? By careful study of Scripture. Jesus made this promise: "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you" (John 15:7).

If you are like me, you tend to gravitate toward the latter part of that verse: "Ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you." We love that, as if God were some sort of genie. But that isn't the case. We tend to forget about the first part of this verse: "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you." If we are walking in fellowship with God and if we are studying the Word of God, then we will start praying according to the will of God; and then we will start seeing our prayers (His will) answered.

1 John 5:14–15 says, "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him." Therefore, we should never give up or back down. We need to keep praying. That is why Jesus said, "ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you" (Matthew 7:7). In the original language, there is an ascending intensity to the terms. It is like starting off with some politeness, then you get more aggressive, and then you are not letting go, like Jacob, who wrestled with the Lord and refused to let go until He blessed him.

This is my desire for my life and yours. No matter what is going on in the world around us, rest assured, God is waiting to join us when we pray His will be done. May that be our goal each day.


