General Writing Tips

Eliminate distractions

If there are distractions, you can lose your focus quickly and interrupt your thought process.

Assume the readers have no prior knowledge

Don't assume that the readers have prior knowledge of the topic. Assuming this will prevent you from jumping to conclusions and missing key points.

Draft an outline

This can help give you a clear direction for your article. Try writing some bullet points to help organize your thoughts and remember the bigger ideas.

Do some research

What facts or statistics will be helpful for readers to know? What will be helpful for you to know before writing? This can also include researching the history and numbers of your own church or school, gathering input from others, or searching online.

Keep it simple

A reader's attention span is generally short, so it may be more beneficial to keep your article direct and concise. Try to eliminate any unnecessary words or phrases. It can sometimes be frustrating for a reader when sentences are too long or wordy.
