PRAYER


I want to ask you and our churches to pray for both Ukraine and Russia. Beside praying for the people in these countries, especially those under attack in Ukraine, remember of Seventh-day Adventist churches and church members.

DONATE

The Russian invasion on Ukraine has created the greatest refugee crisis in Europe since WWII. Since the beginning of the war, more than 3 million people, mostly mothers with children, have crossed the border to neighboring countries of Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Romania, and Moldova. Poland has received 2 million refugees.

Our small SDA Church in Poland (less than 6,000 members in a population of over 38 million) is working tirelessly to minister for people in need. Cars and busses transport food items to Ukraine, bringing refugees on the way back. Relocated people find temporary shelters in our churches, schools, retreat centers, and private homes. Volunteers are helping to find permanent housing and work. Almost every day brings a new initiative of our members trying to help as much as possible.

To support the efforts of our brethren in the Polish Union, the Illinois conference is opening a time limited possibility to donate tax deductible gifts using the Adventist Giving online platform. 100% of donations declared as "Ukraine – Poland" in section "Conference/Union" will be transferred to Polish Union for support of their humanitarian efforts.
