PHILOSOPHY OF ADVENTIST EDUCATION

The Seventh-day Adventist Church recognizes God as the ultimate source of existence, truth, and power. In the beginning God created, in His image, a perfect humanity, a perfection later marred by sin. Education in its broadest sense is a means of returning human beings to their original relationship with God. The distinctive characteristics of this Adventist worldview, built around creation, the fall, redemption, and re-creation, are derived from the Bible and the inspired writings of Ellen G. White.

The aim of true education is to restore human beings into the image of God as revealed by the life of Jesus Christ. Only through the guidance of the Holy Spirit can this be accomplished. An education of this kind imparts far more than academic knowledge. It fosters a balanced development of the whole person—spiritual, physical, intellectual, and social-emotional—a process that spans a lifetime. Working together, homes, schools, and churches cooperate with divine agencies to prepare learners to be good citizens in this world and for eternity.

For every learner to excel in faith, learning, and service, blending biblical truth and academic achievement to honor God and bless others

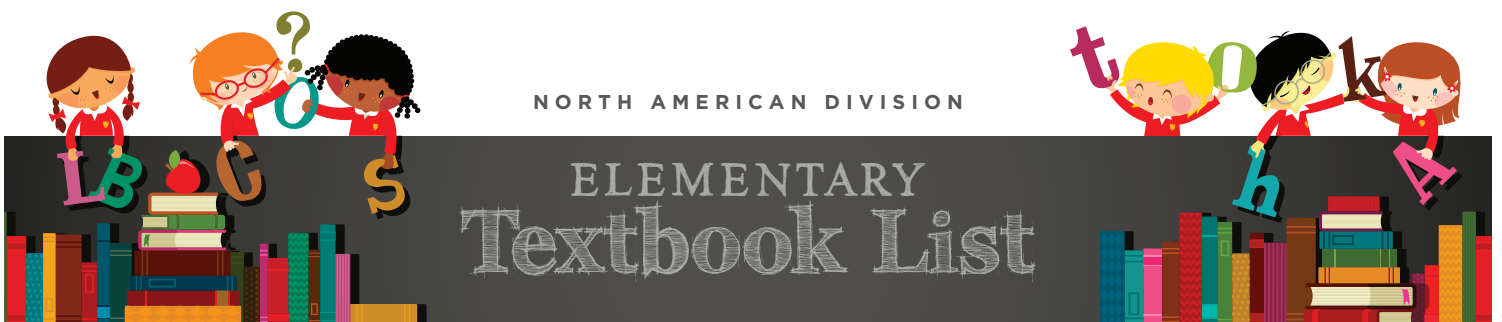
The Adventist worldview accepts the Bible as the standard by which everything else is measured. Four key concepts emerge from a biblical worldview that can be used as a lens for curriculum development, as well as informing the essential questions and big ideas of any content area:

- 1. CREATION**
What is God's intention?
- 2. FALL**
How has God's purpose been distorted?
- 3. REDEMPTION**
How does God help us to respond?
- 4. RE-CREATION**
How can we be restored in the image of God?

As new textbooks are adopted, standards for the respective content areas are developed or revised.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM



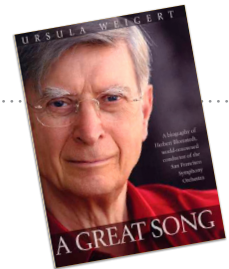

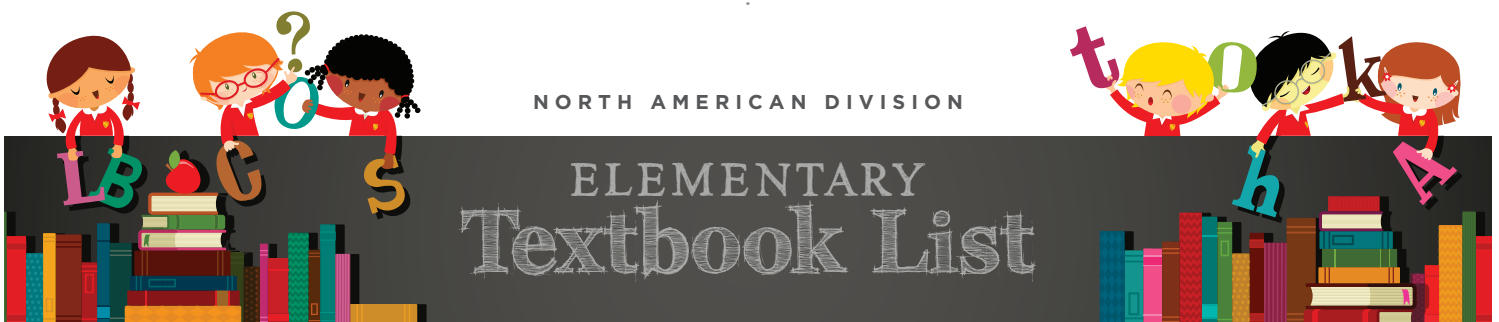

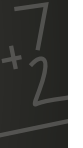

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NAD Textbook SELECTION PROCESS

Elementary education textbooks are reviewed and adopted/developed by the NAD Curriculum Committee, in conjunction with NAD Summer Committees, on a six-to-seven year cycle. Textbooks are selected based on their alignment with Adventist Education Standards. Bible, language arts, and science textbooks are developed so the content intentionally integrates the Adventist worldview. Multi-grade guides for textbooks are available for most content areas.

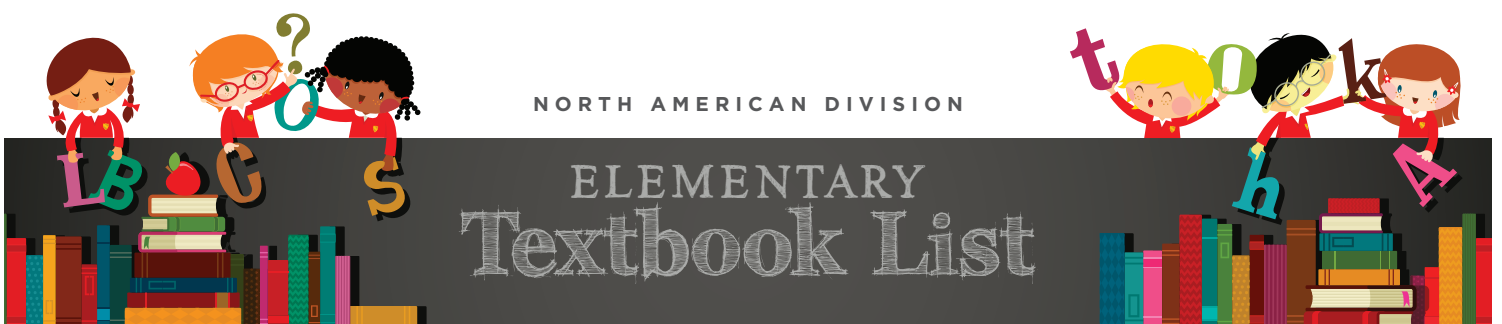
Summer Committees are organized by the NAD Curriculum Committee to assist in the adoption or development of textbooks. Elementary teachers, school/conference/union administrators, and higher education professors, from

across the NAD, are selected to serve on the committees based on their content area expertise. Elementary union associates serve as the chairpersons of the Summer Committees. The responsibilities of the committees include the

review of current content area textbooks, and development of textbook recommendations or materials that align with Adventist Education Standards. Recommendations are then voted by the NAD Education Advisory Committee.

LEVEL #1

Adopted for basic use.

All texts and materials listed in the [Curriculum by Grade](#) section are at Level #1 unless otherwise noted.

LEVEL #4

Approved for information only.

The materials placed in this category are acceptable and may be used in Adventist schools.

LEVEL #2

Approved for basic, supplementary or enrichment use.

The materials placed in this category are highly recommended but not required for use in Adventist schools.

LEVEL #5

Approved in concept, but referred for additional study.

The materials placed in this category are those which require revision or additional editing prior to re-classification and use in Adventist schools.

LEVEL #3

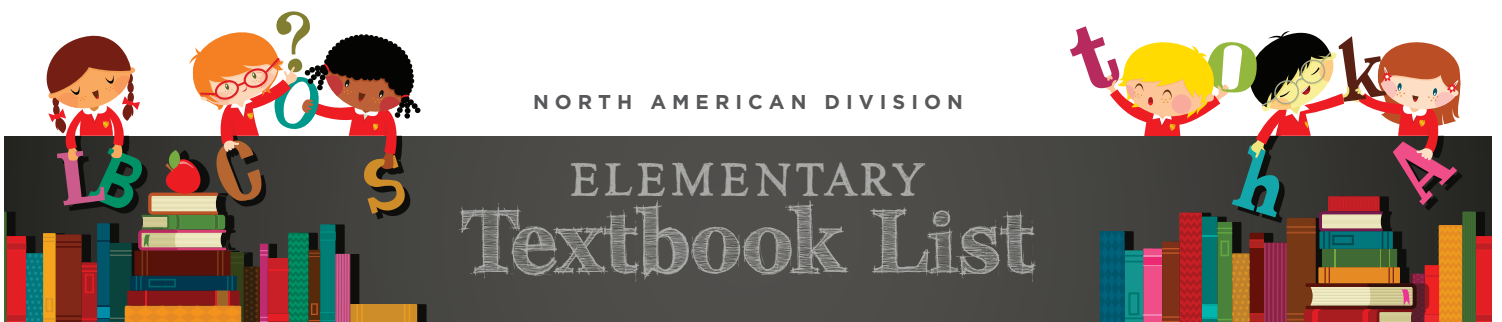
Approved for use in pilot or experimental programs.

The materials placed in this category are those which need field testing or which may be used in pilot or experimental programs. Such material may be returned to the NAD Curriculum Committee for consideration and re-classification.

LEVEL #6

Reviewed, but not approved.

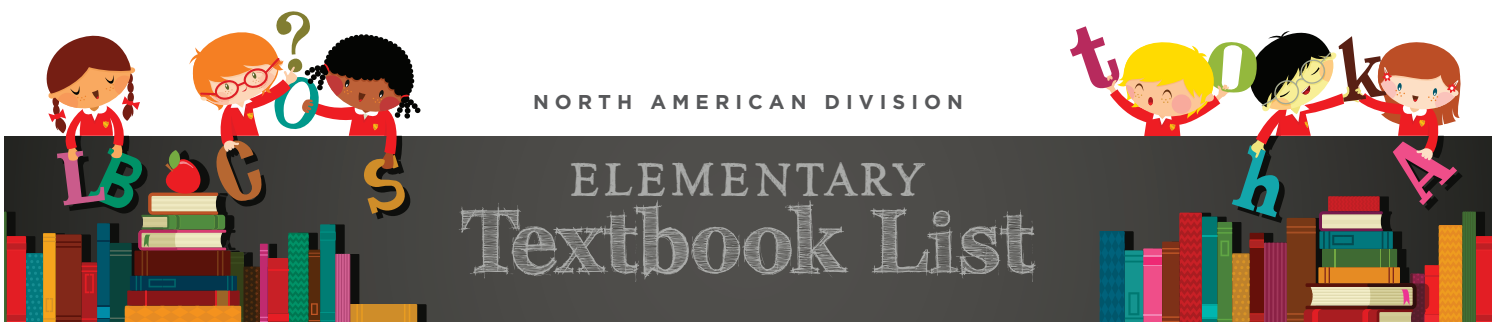

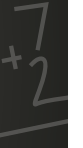

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NAD TESTING Program

IOWA ASSESSMENT SCHEDULE

IOWA test scores are imported to the Student Cumulative Record Report each fall.

Three points of data must match between the SIS and Data Rollup in order for the import to take place:

- NAD Student ID
- birthdate
- full legal name

If there is ANY discrepancy with this information, the data will not import to the Cumulative Record Report.

All conferences have the option of receiving pre-identification barcode labels from Riverside at no additional charge. This is to ensure the most accurate student information and obtain the highest rate of data import success.

The student information is exported directly from the schools' student information system (SIS) data in the Data Rollup app.

Your conference exports the data for the barcode labels directly from their Data Rollup app. All YOU need to do is be sure to enter the student information correctly in your SIS. Please do this as quickly and accurately as possible — prior to the conference-set deadline. Contact them for more information.

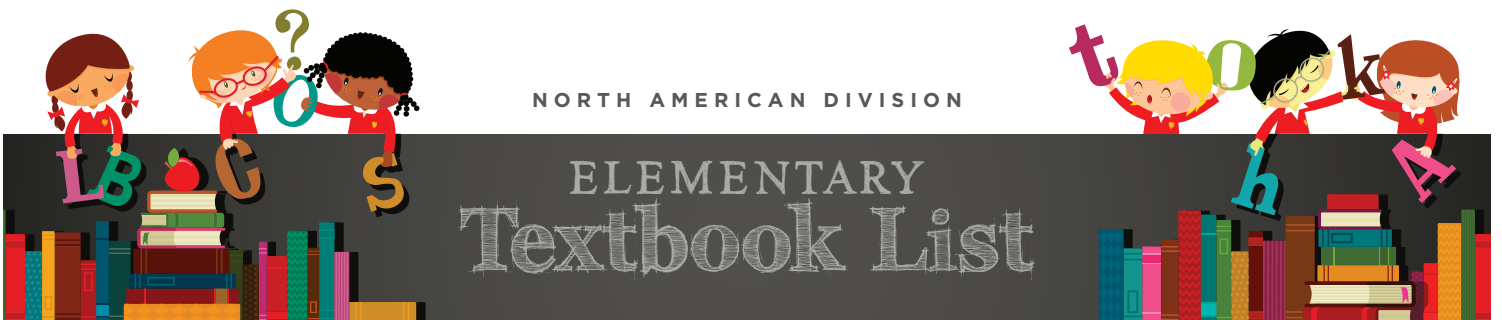
